Sort words into categories to gain a sense of the concepts the categories represent.	4a. The exercises included on the chart backs prompt students to categorize types of nouns by the three categories: person, place, and thing.

The possessive noun chart teaches students that most possessive nouns have an 's or an s' (if plural) at the end of the noun.
